

BODY PARTS of a BEAVER



1. Ears
Beaver's have small rounded ears that can close when they are underwater.

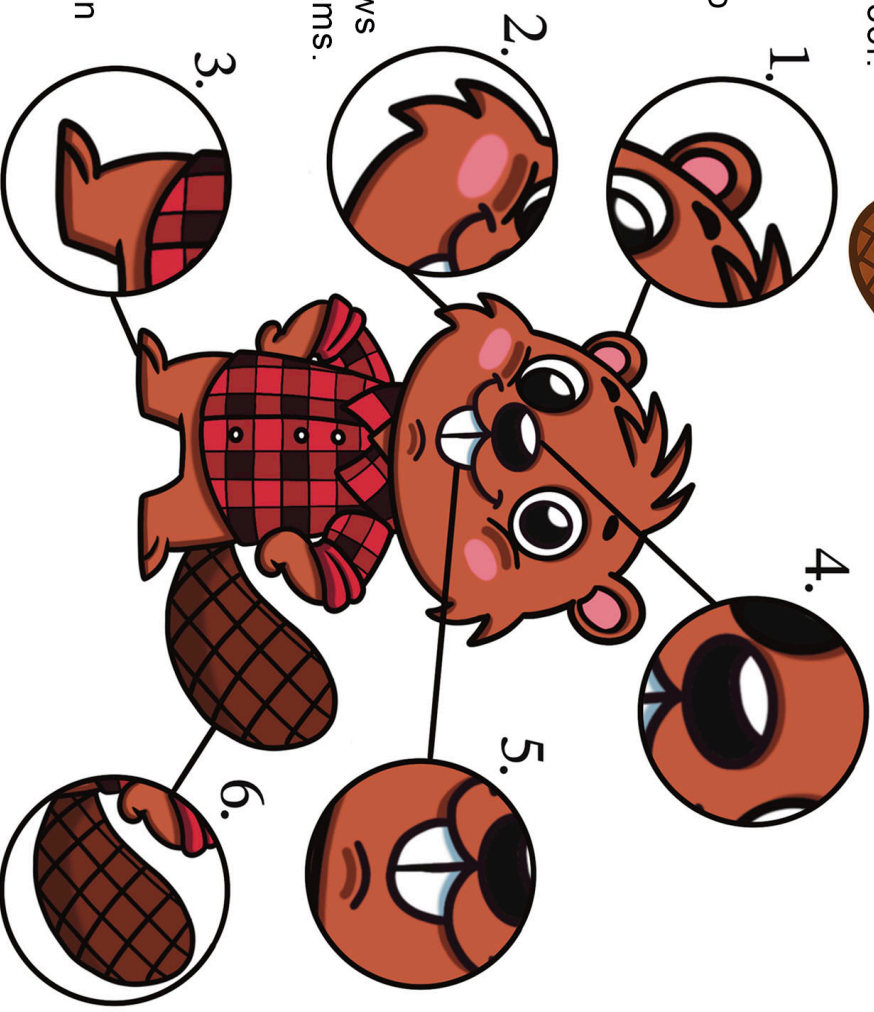
2. Fur
Beaver's have a thick brown fur that is double layered to help keep them warm and it is even water proof.

3. Paws
Their front paws are much smaller than their hind paws and not webbed. This allows them to carry sticks and stones and build dams.

4. Nose
Their nose is highly sensitive to scents and danger. Their nostrils can also close when they are underwater.

5. Teeth
Large sharp teeth that never stop growing allows them to chew on wood needed to build their dams.

6. Tail
One of the most distinctive beaver features: their broad and flat tail. It allows them to steer underwater and helps them balance on land. They can even use it to slap the water and warn others of nearby danger.
